


## WENTWORTH PARISH COUNCIL

Matters Raised By Parishioners 4540.		WRA have asked that consideration be given to publicising the fly tipping imitative with a view that it will be a deterrent in the area. It was noted that WNAA are not in favour of such publicity, but that Councillor Roche will liaise further with WNAA.	DR
4541.		HVP have requested that a donation to the playing field drainage be considered. It was proposed that one third of the amount be donated as per the HVP request.  Proposed Councillor Bradley Seconded Councillor Shaw  Resolved           By unanimous vote, one third of the cost of the drainage works will be paid to HVP on completion of the work and on submission of a copy of the contractors invoice.	
4542.		HVP have advised that the Harley village signs have now been removed for refurbishment and that they will be re-erected in the spring.	
Matters Arising 4543.		RMBC have reported that the tepee equipment at Harley has been condemned due to the posts rotting. The equipment will be removed as soon as possible and HVP notified.	JH
4544.		The Estate has raised no objections to the proposed wedding reception on the Wentworth playing field. Members have no objection in principle, but a strict finish time must be observed and further details of the event and clearing up arrangements must be provided.	JH
4545.		The Estate has confirmed that there is no further update on the reclassification of Street Lane and that the school car park gates are closed at dusk.	
4546.		It was noted that the Estate has had issues of anti social behaviour in the car park. The Estate is to be advised that if it wishes it can include an article in the next newsletter.	
4547.		Wentworth Woodhouse have advised of several events that are to be held over the next few months, it has confirmed that traffic management will be in place.	
4548.		The meeting with the WVCA and others regarding the future of Wentworth pavilion was productive, it was agreed that no one group had legal ownership of the pavilion and that all groups would work together to try and ensure that the building has a viable future. Councillor Bradley is to be the parish council representative on the joint committee to be set up to move the project forward. It has been suggested that that a sub lease could be the best way to allow community groups to access funding for the pavilion.	



	<p>4549. Councillor Roche reported that Harley Lane is to be resurfaced before the end of the year and that funds may be available to repair other roads. Members were asked to submit roads for consideration.</p> <p>4550. Councillor Roche also noted that a small amount of funding has been made available to improve the environment and that several roads have been nominated by ward members for weeding and cleansing. Members noted that the main road through Nether Haugh is particular overgrown with weeds and that the footpath on Angel lane is overgrown. Councillor Roche also commented that there is a small amount of funds available for plants and planters. WRA to be advised.</p> <p>4551. Councillor Roche reported that all powers, other than children's services, would be returned to RMBC in the near future and that a further £40m has to be trimmed from the budget over the next three years.</p> <p>4552. Councillor Shaw asked if RMBC was supporting the sloppy slippers campaign, this is a scheme supported by some wards in the BMBC area.</p> <p>4553. Parishioners have also asked if RMBC could give consideration to extending the green bin collections which cease at the end of October. Councillor Roche noted that this will be looked at in the forthcoming budget.</p> <p>4554. The formation of a community band is to be deferred until the December meeting.</p> <p>4555.
