The group has received donations from Wentworth Charites and from a Harley resident who is pleased to see the rejuvenation of the hall. Councillor Shaw thanked Councillor McNamara for helping with the autumn fayre and for the loan of chairs.</p> <p>A Harley resident has complained about the improvements to the Harley bus shelter noting that the green waste was not properly taken away and that the step needs painting.</p> <p>It was noted that the pavements in Harley have been sprayed to treat the moss.</p> <p>It was noted that the Mayor will attend the Harley Christmas fayre, but will not be opening it, and that all available stalls have been taken.</p> <p>Dr Billings is to attend a meeting with Harley residents, similar to the one held in Wentworth earlier, it is believed the new Neighbourhood Policing Inspector will also attend.</p> <p>It was noted that there has been an increase in burglaries in the area over the past month and the PCSOs are to be asked to attend the next meeting.</p> <p>The manhole covers on Main Street, reported earlier for being noisy, have been inspected and found to be satisfactory. Members do not agree and ask the matter be referred to Councillor Roche for further investigation.</p> <p>Two further prosecutions for fly tipping are potentially being considered. RMBC have asked if the parish council will fund new signage, this will warn off potential fly tippers and also allow easier surveillance of fly tipping hotspots.</p> <p>Proposed Councillor McNamara Seconded Councillor Crawford</p> <p>Resolved By unanimous vote six signs are to be purchased to aid the fly tipping initiative.</p> <p>It was noted that an article has appeared in the local press regarding the possible closure of Wentworth cricket club due to lack of players.</p> <p>The perspex on the Nether Haugh telephone box has been vandalised. Matter to be reported to BT.</p> <p>The Remembrance service was well attended and there has been good feedback from parishioners. Thanks were expressed to Councillor Sykes for arranging the event.</p> <p>Mrs Hellewell and Mr Cook left the meeting at 7.55pm</p> <p>It was noted that Mr Daley has ceased to be a parish councillor.</p> <p>A complaint has been received fro Mr & Mrs Sabin regarding the bugler at the remembrance service.
